YOUR NEW TANK DESTROYER WAR MEMORIAL WILL BE LOCATED IN THE HEIRT O FT. HOOD IN JUST ABOUT THE MOST PROMINENT SPOT ON THE ENTIRE POST!

Leaving the Expressway, you turn North on Hood Road and pass the old Main Gate. As you come over the crest of the hill you have a dramatic view of the largest military post in the Free World

Most of the buildings are still in the distance. You approach the first intersection. You find the crossroad is Tank Destroyer Blvd, and the volume of traffic calls for a stop light. Your wary own Tank Destroyer War Memorial sits proudly in front of a ling of trees on the NE corner of this intersection.



Our memorial will be both simple and impressive. Basically, it will be a rough-hewn cylinder of Texas red granite. The top portion will be machined and polished, with deep-cut lettering to honor all who served with the TD's during WWII. The center of all this will be a reproduction of our black panther TD patch.

You will find a certain warmth to this rugged piece of stone. It will express your own pride in having served your country. And, there will be a certain satisfaction knowing that this tribute to all will stand there for years to come for your children and mine

This will be the 2nd National TD Reunion to be organized by your Tank Destroyer Association On this occasion we will have the distinct honor and pleasure of formally dedicating our very own Tank Destroyer War Memorial. This will be a permanent monument and it will honor all who served with the TD's during World War II. It should be a very impressive dedication ceremény
