Dear Sean

I just received your letter and pictures today.
The zip code was wrong and it delayed delivery.

I have done my best to give you identifications,
but you must realize it has been almost 46 years since
the war was over - and at 71 years of age the old "thinker"
gets a little bogged down.

One of the reasons for not knowing all the names is
that as soon as the war was over Major Nelson, Col. Yancey,
and I were transferred on detached duty to Third Army Hqs.
in Bad Tölz, Germany from early July to October 1945.

I remember your dad very well - he was a real
cut up. However he and I worked in different jobs - his
at the end of the war was working in supply and mine
was keeping maps for Hqs. The last time I saw him
was at Bad Reibling, Germany where our outfit had
a large PW camp on an airfield. Most of the 1st TD Brig.
~~etc~~ went home lots earlier than I did, due to my
job at 3rd Army Hqs.

Another reason for not knowing some of the names is
that as time went by there were quite a few changes in
personnel.

I am sending along with your pictures a menu for
Thanksgiving, 1943 while we were at Camp Claiborne, La.,
for your perusal; take your time with it, but please
return it to me in the future. Also enclosing picture
of myself (Sept 1945 - Bad Tölz, Germany). I'd like to have this
photo also.
