INACTIVATION OF UNITS

1. PAC, Ltr, ASF, NYPE, Brooklyn, NY, file SP1AA 322 GM (CAD)(45-6373), dtd 21 Nov '45, Subject: Inactivation of Certain Units, the fol units are inactivated eff 2359 hours 25 Nov '45 and transferred in an inactive status to the control of the War Department:-

776th Tank Destroyer Battalion (Heavy self-propelled)
601st Ordnance Base Armament Maintenance Battalion
(includes attached Medical)
305th Military Police Escort Guard Company
595th Military Police Escort Guard Company

2. a. Personnel will be transferred by this headquarters to appropriate Reception Stations, as prescribed in RRI-6 for disposition.

b. No personnel will be reduced in grade as result of this action. Excess in grades resulting therefrom will be absorbed through normal attrition and the application of the provisions of AR 615-5, 30 June 1943, as amended.

3. Equipment will be turned into Area Commander as prescribed in Section VII, RRI-6 and by Area Commanding Officer.

4. Personnel Records will be prepared and processed under the supervision of Area Commanding Officer in accordance with provisions of paragraph 11e, RRI-6.

5. Unit funds and physical property thereof will be disposed of as prescribed in Section IV, RRI-6, and by Chief, Fiscal Branch, this headquarters.

6. Records of the inactivated units will be disposed of and reported to this headquarters by Area Commanding Officer in accordance with AR 15-15, dtd 20 Sept '45 and as prescribed in Section VIII, RRI-6.
