

Sons Proud of Polish-Born Parents Join Army to Redeem Liberty of Ancestral Home

Two sons of the late Mr. and Mrs. Ignatius W. Borowski, Polish-born residents of the city, are with the U.S. Army overseas.

One of the brothers, Pvt. Frank W., is the soldier who helped to destroy three Nazi tanks in a daring 10-minute fight on the Anzio beachhead, prior to the fall of Rome.

The other brother is Pfc. Edward W., who is in an engineers combat battalion in England.

The two young men are of a family of 11 children of Mr. and Mrs. Borowski.

The father was born in Warsaw, Poland, and came to America when he was 18 years of age. The family has resided in Williamsport for more than two decades. Mr. Borowski worked at the Armour Leather Company.
