PFC Gerald J. Keyes Is Reported Killed in Action

Word has been received here that PFC Gerald J. Keyes, well-known Helena man, was killed in action in France, July 9. Relatives here were previously notified that he was wounded on the same day.

Private Keyes, who attended St. Mary's school, Helena high school, and Carroll college, had been in the service for two and one-half years.

Following his induction into the army he trained in various California camps and near Las Vegas, Nev. He was formerly stationed in England.

Surviving relatives include his grandfather, James E. Keyes, a cousin, Mrs. Dan Munson, an uncle, James McHugh, and an aunt, Mrs. W. A. Burton, all of Helena, and an uncle, Lloyd Keyes, of California.
