Arlington Burial For Lieut. Jarvie

Lieutenant John Scott Jarvie of this city, who was killed while fighting with the Allied Fifth Army near Rome, Italy, May 29, 1944, was buried in Arlington National Cemetery on Tuesday in Virginia.

Lieutenant Jarvie was the son of Mrs. Albert L. Jarvie of 816 Centre Street. He is also survived by two sisters, Mrs. Charles Williamson of Yardley and Miss Isabelle Jarvie of the Centre Street address, and six brothers, Albert L. of Hollywood, Fla.; Walter of Lawrenceville, and William, Philip, George and Richard Jarvie of Trenton.

A graduate of Bordentown Military Institute in 1936, Lieutenant Jarvie was employed by the DeLaval Steam Turbine Company before entering the service. He was serving with an anti-tank division at the time of his death.
