I. AWARD OF SILVER STAR: By direction of the President, and under the provisions of AR 600-45, as amended and Ltr Hq - - Cerps, File AG 200.6, 16 October 1944, the Silver Star is awarded to the following:

Chief Warrant Officer, STANLEY D PIERSON, W-2113684. 607th Tank Destroyer Battalien, for gallantry in action against the enemy, on 7 October 1:44, in the vicinity of St Privat, France. Warrant Officer PIERSON displayed outstanding combat skill and courage in an assualt on a German pillbox near St Privat, on 7 October 1944. After he had voluntarily led a patrel under fierce fire to within twenty feet of the objective Warrent Officer PIERSON ordered protective fire while he rushed the millbox entrance alone. Under cover of smoke and supporting fire Warrant Officer PIERSON reached the entrance, threw a hand grenade into the pilloox, and rushed inside. His cold foray stunned the enemy and the five German soldiers occupying the position surrendered to him. The daring ladership and determined devotion to duty given by Chief Warrant Officer PIERSON reflect great credit en him and are in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service.
