

HISTORY OF THE 704TH TANK DESTROYER BATTALION

The 704th Tank Destroyer Battalion was activated at Pine Camp and attached to the Fourth Armored Division on December 15, 1941. Its cadre consisted of seven officers and 101 enlisted men of Battery D, 22nd Field Artillery Battalion (Armored). The Battalion's first commander was Major Douglas Cameron, promoted to Lieutenant Colonel in February, assigned from Headquarters, Fourth Armored Division.

Individual training was initiated immediately with the view of preparing the men for efficient individual and team duty. Crew and squad training was begun in February, 1942, with improvised self-propelled weapons consisting of 75-mm. guns mounted on two-and-one-half-ton trucks. A reconnaissance company was formed in February. Selected men from all companies formed a special training and demonstration tank destroyer platoon for an intensive course of training under the Commanding General of Combat Command A.

In March night training and bivouac procedure became part of the schedule as the men became proficient in their individual and crew assignments. This training schedule was revised, however, when 246 men were assigned to the Battalion from the Fourth Armored Division Training Center. Use was made of the Special Training Platoon and the "County Fair" system of instruction in order to train these men as quickly as possible in the tactics of the tank destroyer battalion. The Battalion was further augmented on

April 11 by the arrival from Fort Knox, Kentucky, of 80 enlisted men who had completed their basic training at the Armored Force Replacement Center.

The Battalion assisted in the celebration of the Fourth Armored Division's anniversary April 15 by firing a reveille salute of six 75-mm. guns. The salute was the first time a shot had been fired from a major weapon of the Battalion. A noon salute was also given by the Battalion at the Division's Independence Day celebration and review.

When Lieutenant Colonel Cameron left the Battalion on April 30 he was succeeded by Lieutenant Colonel Hayden Sears who served as Commanding Officer for 10 days. Lieutenant Colonel Louis J. Storck succeeded Lieutenant Colonel Sears, May 13, and he was in turn followed by Major Delk M. Oden as Commanding Officer on June 22.

The spring and summer brought intensified training on a company and battalion scale. Before the month of June had passed the Battalion was carrying its full share of the field exercises and it began to have the appearance of a seasoned outfit. Realizing the limited time for preparation for maneuvers and the other serious business that was ahead, the officers and men applied themselves to their tasks with a determination to be prepared for whatever mission they might be called upon to fulfill.
