



KILLED — Private Clarence A. Fore, 29, was killed in action in France November 23, 1944, according to a report received by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. J. S. Fore, 1419 Brundage Lane. He had enlisted in February, 1941, and was assigned to field artillery. He had been in Europe since January, 1944, and was transferred to a tank destroyer outfit. Private Fore attended Bakersfield High School and Junior College and was a star football player on the 1932 and 1933 teams. Besides his parents, he is survived by his two sisters, Gladys Grant and Vivian Kahler, both of Bakersfield, and two brothers, his twin, Cecil Fore, now in France, and Ray Fore, Bakersfield
