Technician Fourth Grade Darrell E. Williams, (then Corporal), 39910864, Corps of Engineers, while serving in the Army of the United States, distinguished himself by meritorious service in connection with military operations not involving aerial flight against an enemy of the United States. During the period 10 April 1945 to 8 May 1945, at Oberstein, Germany, he was delegated a large share of the task of locating and disposing of vast quantities of Captured Enemy Engineer Materials. This he accomplished with a high degree of efficiency. His efforts resulted in the diversion to United States Troops of much sorely needed supplies and equipment which would have otherwise been virtually impossible to obtain. His initiative in obtaining needed supplies for American Troops contributed materially to the success of Engineer supply in the Rheinprovinz, first area to be occupied and governed by Allied troops in Germany. The outstanding devotion to duty and untiring efforts displayed by Technician Fourth Grade Williams reflect great credit upon himself and the armed forces of the United States.
