CITATION FOR BRONZE CAK-LEAF CLUSTER TO THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL

Captain John D. Singer (army Serial No OSLELES), Medical Corps, United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations as Area Surgeon for three marshalling camps, from 9 April 1944 to 5 July 1944. Although on duty as Battalion Surgeon, 773rd Tank Destroyer Battalion, Captain Singer was called upon to act as surgeon for Sub-Area "W" (a part of Marshalling Area "D"). Here, he supervised medical sanitary facilities resulting in the sub-area having the highest senitary reting in the marshalling area. His excellent supervision of the three marshalling camps D-1, D-3 and D-6, resulted in the handling of 42,500 troops without an epidemie of any upper respiratory diseases. Captain Singer also supervised the duties of eight medical officers, one dental officer and forty-eight enlisted men, and took eare of eight enlisted men's messes, four officers' messes and three British messes.
