

LT. R. L. HOLLIS DIES IN FRANCE

1st Lt. Romaine L. Hollis, 1519 North Alder street, died in an army hospital in France, Sept. 17, from wounds suffered two days earlier in Germany, according to word received here Friday.

Lt. Hollis was a member of Troop B of the Washington National Guard, a Tacoma unit, and was a member of the 193rd Anti Tank battalion when it was organized in Tacoma in Sept., 1940. He was called to active duty Feb. 10, 1943.

He had been overseas about four months and was a member of a tank destroyer unit, but had been transferred from that of which he was a member originally.

Before going into active service he was employed in the adjutant's office of the Washington National Guard at Camp Murray.

Besides his wife, Kay, he is survived by a daughter.
