FENNIMORE, Wis.—Four of the five service sons of Mr. and Mrs. William Hirsch are overseas. They are Sgt. Elmer Hirsch, 24, Corps. Leonard, 26, and William Hirsch, 22, and Pfc. Edward Hirsch, 21, Corp. Arthur Hirsch, 28, formerly of the army air forces, received a medical discharge after more than a year in service.

Arthur entered service Oct. 8, 1942, and was discharged in December, 1943.

Elmer, who entered service

Nov. 5, 1941, went to Iceland in April, 1942. He now is in Germany after service in Ireland and England. A member of the infantry, Elmer was wounded seriously but recovered and returned to action.

Leonard enlisted Jan. 9, 1942, went overseas in March, 1943, and, after service in Africa and Sicily, is in Italy with the Fifth AAF. His wife lives in Lancaster.

Wilbur is with a tank destroyer division in Belgium, after service in England, France, and Luxembourg. He entered service Oct. 20, 1942, and went overseas last May.

Edward entered service Jan. 10, 1943, and went overseas the following October. He is with an anti-aircraft unit in the south Pacific.
